

Simulate the Real Exam

This is the last practice exam. Do your best to make it feel like the real thing. Before you begin:

- Put away your phone and any electronic devices not permitted on the real AP[®] Physics 1 exam. Turn off all notifications on your computer.
- Have with you: your calculator, a ruler with a straight edge, a pencil or pen with black or dark blue ink, and the printed Free-Response Booklet if possible. Print the booklet before you begin, as it is listed before the multiple-choice section this time.
- Set aside 3 hours and 10 minutes: 80 minutes for Section 1, a 10-minute break, and 100 minutes for Section 2.
- **Do not look at any solutions while taking the exam.** You want this to be as close to the real exam experience as possible.

After the Exam

- Wait until you have completed the entire exam before watching the two companion videos. They are placed after both sections of the exam intentionally.
- Review your Section 1 results, compare them to the solutions, then watch the after-Section-1 video.
- Review your Section 2 answers using the grading rubric provided in the solutions, then watch the after-Section-2 video.
